The examiner will ask questions on the topics below. You can read an example question for each topic

Part 1 (3-4 minutes)

LIKES AND DISLIKES What do you like doing at weekends/with your friends?	VISITING PEOPLE AND PLACES Which country/city in the world would you most like to visit?
PAST EXPERIENCES Have you ever had a part time job? Did you like it? Why/Why not?	FUTURE PLANS Where would you like to live in the future? Why?
